Hawai'i Pacific Health is offering free online Advance Care Planning classes.

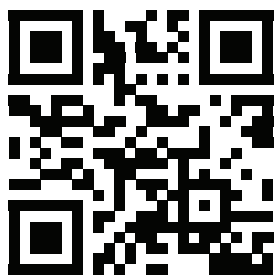
Register and attend with your family and friends to learn the importance of advance care planning.
