
## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR CITI TRAINING**


STEP 1: Open your internet program and go the CITI website at <u>www.citiprogram.org</u>.

- STEP 2: Create an account by clicking on the Register button.
  - If you have an existing CITI account you can affiliate with HPH. Refer to instructions on page 3.



STEP 3: Type in Hawai'i Pacific Health Research Institute when asked to Select Your Organization Affiliation

STEP 4: Create your user name and password and complete account setup.

• CE Credit is available for purchase. HPH does not pay for CE credits.

STEP 5: Once you have completed your account setup, you will see the courses you need to complete. Click on the Start Now button to begin the training.

• Some course have Supplemental modules available. You are not required to complete these modules.



Good Clinical Practice training takes approximately 4-6 hours to complete, Human Subject Research (Biomedical) training takes approximately 4-5 hours to complete, and IPS training takes approximately 1 hour to complete depending on your familiarity with the material.

Once you have completed your training a certificate of completion will automatically be sent to the Hawai'i Pacific Health Research Institute.

Training expires 3 years from your date of completion.

The CITI website contains answers to many commonly asked questions.



## Affiliate with HPHRI

STEP 1: Login to your existing CITI account.

STEP 2: Select the link to Add Institutional Affiliation.



STEP 4: Provide the requested information.

STEP 5: When you start a course you will need to complete any modules listed as Incomplete. The additional modules to complete will vary based on the courses you have previously done. You will not be able to complete the Hawai'i Pacific Health Research module until you have completed all other incomplete modules.

Once you have completed the additional modules a completion certificate will automatically be sent to the Hawai'i Pacific Health Research Institute.
