About Wilcox Medical Center and Kaua'i Medical Clinic:

Wilcox Health, which comprises Wilcox Medical Center and Kaua'i Medical Clinic, is part of Hawai'i Pacific Health.

Founded in 1938, Wilcox Medical Center is a not-for-profit medical center dedicated to providing the Kaua'i community with accessible quality health care. The largest medical center on Kaua'i, it is a state-of-the-art acute care facility with a full suite of services offering 30 specialties and programs, including cardiology, emergency, family practice, gastroenterology, health management, internal medicine, neurology, OB-GYN, oncology, orthopedics, pediatrics and urology. Its 18-bed emergency department serves as the island's Primary Stroke Center. The medical center also has four birthing suites, seven intensive care beds and 20 same-day surgery beds. Wilcox is the first American College of Surgeons-verified Level III Trauma Center in the state of Hawai'i.

Kaua'i Medical Clinic is the island's largest clinic and only multispecialty medical group. Nearly 100 providers offer primary and specialty care at clinic locations in 'Ele'ele, Kapa'a, Kōloa and Līhu'e. Kaua'i Medical Clinic also offers an urgent care clinic in Līhu'e that is open daily.
