Hawai'i Pacific Health is proudly home of two Nationally Accredited Breast Programs (NAPBC) and three Women's Centers across the state. We are dedicated to improving the quality of care for patients with diseases of the breast. Receiving breast care at Hawai'i Pacific Health you can be assured that is held to the highest standards of care.

Our Women Centers provide funfilled events that include manicures, massages, and makeovers but most importantly education and mammograms are done at our facilities.

- On September 28th, Pali Momi Women's Center Girls Night Out attract 86 women from West Oahu! Three women had a follow up mammogram with no positive outcomes.
- Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women and Children's Women
 Center offered "Celebrate Me" in town on October 18th. Ten Women were screened and 3 required additional views and 6 month follow up.
- At Wilcox Medical Center, a fun-filled evening in education on May 17, 2018, resulted in 21women signing up for mammography with 6 completing. Thankfully, all had negative outcomes.
- On May 3rd, Straub Medical Center, along with its sister Women Centers participated in the Women's Way to Health at the Prince Waikiki. Leading to scheduling of many Mammogram
