Wilcox Medical Center is administering the Comirnaty vaccine (formerly called Pfizer) for ages 12 and older, the Moderna vaccine for ages 18 and older and the Johnson & Johnson single dose vaccine for ages 18 and older.

Third doses of the Pfizer and Moderna mRNA COVID-19 vaccines for immunocompromised individuals are available by appointment only **28** days after the last dose.

Booster doses of the Pfizer vaccine for ages 65 and older **or** ages 18 and older with underlying health conditions **or** who are at high risk for occupational or institutional exposure are available by appointment only **6 calendar months** after the last Pfizer dose.

### COVID-19 VACCINATIONS ARE SCHEDULED AT WILCOX AS FOLLOWS:

Wednesday	October 20	10 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
Friday	October 22	10 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

- Third doses of the Pfizer vaccine are for immunocompromised people aged 12 and older 28 days or longer after the last Pfizer dose.
- Third doses of the Moderna vaccine are for immunocompromised people aged 18 and older 28 days or longer after the last Moderna dose.
- Booster doses of the Pfizer vaccine are not authorized for people under the age of 18. Boosters are available for eligible people aged 18 and older 6 calendar months or longer after the last Pfizer dose.

**Appointments are required for all third doses.** Walk-ins will be taken for first and second doses only. Vaccine recipients must be at least 12 years old. Those under the age of 18 need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian, who will need to sign a consent form. Please bring a picture I.D. and an insurance card, if you have one.
