Important Information About Your Monoclonal Antibody Therapy.

The entrance and exit to the Monoclonal Antibody (MAB) Treatment Clinic at Wilcox Medical Center is through the secured side entrance, facing Walmart.

ARRIVAL:

Please park in one of the "reserved" parking spaces next to the Infusion Center entrance. Upon arrival, please call the MAB nurse at 245-1277 and let them know what vehicle you are in. PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE until security arrives to escort you to the secured door to enter and exit.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU:

Please come alone and bring your face mask.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR APPOINTMENT:

The therapy takes about 2.5 hours in total. This includes one hour of observation after treatment for your safety and well-being. You will be contacted a few days after treatment to see how you are feeling.

Please note that everyone entering the facility must wear a mask and practice appropriate physical distancing.

PATIENT ESCORTS FOR SPECIAL ASSISTANCE:

A wheelchair can be provided if needed.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Two family members can be treated at the same time, if appropriate.

Please go to the bathroom before arriving.
