Wilcox Medical Center is administering the Pfizer vaccine for ages 5-11.

Each person receiving a vaccine needs their own appointment.

Appointments need to be scheduled under the patient's name (not the parent or guardian's name).

If you wish to schedule several appointments, you may not be able to get the same appointment times, however if you all have appointments and come together, we will make every effort to accommodate your group. This may cause a delay from your scheduled time.

All minors ages 5 to 11 years old must be accompanied to their appointment by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian who makes the appointment grants permission for the vaccine to be given.

This vaccine clinic is for 5-11 year olds and their families and only the Pfizer vaccine will be available. Adults can schedule an appointment on Wednesdays from 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

Appointments are required. Vaccine recipients must be 5 years old on the day of the appointment. Those under the age of 18 need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian, who will need to sign a consent form. Please bring a picture I.D. and an insurance card, if you have one.
