

# Kaua'i Mobile Vaccine Clinics for 12+

The Kaua'i Mobile Vaccine Clinic is a partnership between the County of Kaua'i, Hawaii Health Systems Corporation and Wilcox Health.

Staff at the mobile vaccine clinics administer the Pfizer vaccine for ages 12 and older and the Moderna vaccine for ages 18 and older.

Third doses of the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for immunocompromised individuals are available **28 days** after the last dose.

Pfizer boosters are available for people ages 12 and older **5 calendar months** or longer after the last dose. Moderna boosters are available for people ages 18 and older **5 calendar months** or longer after the last dose.

**The Johnson & Johnson vaccine and vaccinations for children ages 5-11 are not offered at the mobile vaccine clinic.**
