Outstanding collaborative skills and a strong interest in multidisciplinary work and community outreach are essential. Located in Honolulu, we are the only Children's Hospital in the state and receive consultations from military and community hospitals on neighbor Hawaiian islands and the Pacific region. The Kapi'olani Child Protection Center was founded in 1974 and over time has been staffed by board certified pediatricians as well as experienced academic generalists. The Center is staffed with over 40 professionals including experienced psychologists, social workers, a legislative analyst, a board eligible child abuse pediatrician, adolescent gynecologist, several general pediatricians with years of child abuse experience and ob/gyns helping with older sexual assault victims. We have outstanding working relationships with the Departments of Health and Human Services as well as key child health legislators.
