

Advanced Burn Life Support (ABLS) Provider Course

Course Description

Knowledge for immediate care of the burn patient up to the first 24 hours post injury. Emergency preparedness, mass casualty incidents focusing on triage, burn survivability, prioritizing transport of patients and patient treatment.

Live hands on, 8 hour course for physicians, nurses, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, therapists, and paramedics.

Burn transfer criteria to Straub Medical Center Burn Unit.

Lectures, and case studies are presented for group discussions.

Simulated burn patient scenarios to reinforce the assessment, and stabilization of burn patients.

Testing consists of a written exam and a practical assessment.

Intended Audience

The audience for the ABLS program is anyone who may come into early contact with a burn injury. This includes fire fighters, EMTs, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, therapists, emergency physicians and nurses, pediatricians and pediatric nurses, first responders, military personnel and many others.
