HERE ARE SOME DETAILS ABOUT OUR NEW ECG MONITOR SYSTEM:

- Can be worn up to 14 days
- Single use
- Water-resistant
- Discreet – worn under clothing
- No wires, boxes, battery charging needed
- No electrodes or patch changes

The new ECG monitoring system is able to rule-in and rule-out cardiac arrhythmias sooner than other monitoring devices due to its ability to store up to 333 hours of continuous analyzable ECG data. This provides physicians with the information needed for earlier diagnosis and treatment.

THE ECG MONITOR DETECTS:

- True AFib Burden
- Atrial Flutter
- Atrial Fibrillation
- Supraventricular Ectopy
- Supraventricular Tachycardia
- Pause
- AV Block
- Ventricular Tachycardia
- Ventricular Ectopy/Premature Ventricular Contractions

WHO CAN BENEFIT FROM THE NEW ECG MONITOR?

The ECG monitor is ideal for patients who may be asymptomatic or who may be suffering from the following symptoms:

- Palpitations
- Shortness of Breath
- Dizziness
- Light-headedness
- Syncope/Pre-syncope
- Fatigue
- Anxiety
